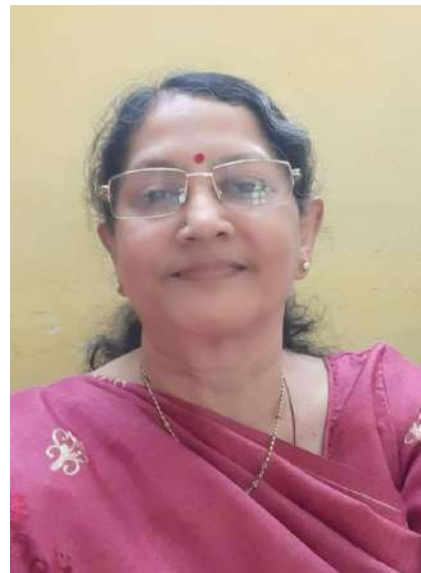

Session Highlights:

1. First Resource person was Mr. Vivek Tiwari, Head, Department of Computer Applications. Mr. Tiwari delivered a session focusing on commonly used AI tools in academic research, including ChatGPT, Grammarly, Quillbot, Research Rabbit, and Elicit. He explained their functions, applications, limitations, and importance in research, using simple and clear language suitable for beginners.
2. Second Resource person, Dr. Arun Kumar Kashyap, Head, Department of Biotechnology, presented a detailed talk on Mendeley Reference Manager. He guided participants through the process of account creation, managing research papers, linking references in text, and preparing bibliographies using Mendeley.
3. Dr. Santosh Agrawal, Head, Department of Zoology, was the third resource person. He delivered a lecture on the features and uses of Zotero Reference Manager. He emphasized Zotero as an open-source tool that helps in organizing and managing research references efficiently.

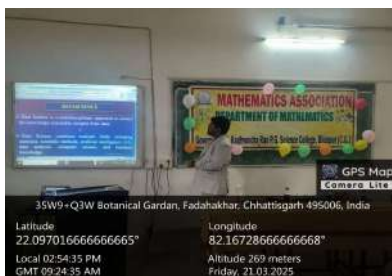
Guest Lectures

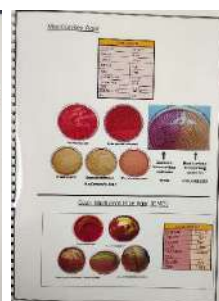
Guest Lectures

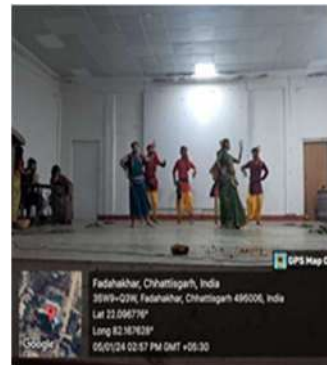
